GOVERNMENT OF BIHAR IN COMPLIANCE OF THE ORDER

DATED 13.7.2015 IN THE AFOREMENTIONED MATTER

I, Vivek Kumar Singh, son of Late Rudradeo Narayan Singh, aged about 51 years, resident of L/62, S.K. Nagar, Chakaram, Patna do hereby solemnly affirm and state as under:-

1. That I am presently posted as the Principal Secretary, Department of Environment and Forests, Government of Bihar, Patna. I am well aware of the facts and circumstances of the matter on the basis of information derived from the records.
2. That in compliance of order dated 20.3.2015, it is respectfully submitted that an affidavit dated 23.4.2015 has been filed on 24.4.2015 on behalf of the Government of Bihar vide which the decision of the Government to accept the "Model Action

Plan for Municipal Solid Waste Management" based on the Haryana Model has been brought on record.

3. That vide order dated 13.7.2015 the Hon'ble Tribunal pleased to direct the deponent to file status report with regard to collection, storage and disposal of Municipal Solid Waste in the entire State.
4. That it is respectfully submitted that the relevant Department in the State of Bihar in regard to the directions as contained in the order of this Hon'ble Tribunal would be the Urban Development Department of the Government of Bihar. However, on enquiry from the said Department, the deponent respectfully submits that there is no town in the State of Bihar where the Municipal Solid Waste is collected in its entirety, segregated and disposed of in accordance with MSW Rules, 2000. However, efforts are being made by the ULBs to select agencies for processing of waste to convert into compost, RDF and energy.
5. That it is further submitted that there is no MSW disposal plant in the State of Bihar. However, the Patna Municipal Corporation (PMC) has proposal for setting up of a processing and disposal facilities at Ramchak Bairia, Patna.

Further, Environmental clearance from the SEIAA and Authorisation u/r 6(3) of the MSW(M&H) Rules, 2000 have

already been granted on the 28th November, 2013 and on the 9th of December, 2013 respectively to the PMC.


