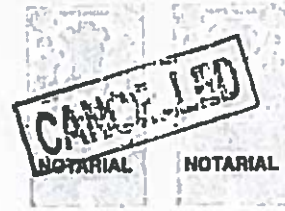

**AN AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF CHHATTISGARH IN
COMPLIANCE OF THE DIRECTIONS DT. 20.03.15**

The Respondent most respectfully begs to submit as under:-

I, Sanjeev Beohar, son of late Shri.B.S.Beohar aged about 54 years, presently officiating as Superintending Engineer, Directorate of Urban Administration and Development, Government of Chhattisgarh, do hereby solemnly affirm as under:-

1. That the State of Chhattisgarh has duly filed an affidavit before this Tribunal on 15th Jan 2015 and 25th Feb. 2015. That solid waste management is under implementation in all 169 towns in the State;

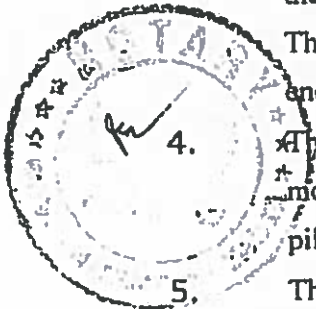
2. That the answering respondents have duly examined the Punjab model. However, because of the topography (spatial distances) and other differences between Punjab and Chhattisgarh, it is not feasible to opt for use of garbage in the State for Power Generation in a centralized plant. The State already has surplus power.

3. That answering respondents have been impressed by the administrative and enforcement aspects included in the Punjab model and have begun an exercise for revision of the DPRs to incorporate these aspects. A committee of officials has been set up for this task. The Executive Order No. 340 dated 14.01.2015 relating to this is enclosed as R/1.

4. That answering respondents have duly examined the Karnal cluster model that the Government of Haryana proposes to implement as a pilot;

5. That answering respondents are duly impressed by the Karnal model, however, we believe that though the basics remain the same in all models, the details of the model will be guided by local specifics;

6. That in particular the cluster approach cannot be the only approach. Owing to the spatial distances in the State of Chhattisgarh. In Chhattisgarh a mix of the centralized and the de-centralized models is being opted for.
7. That answering respondents are committed to involving rag pickers in the work of municipal solid waste management in a manner based on the Karnal model;
8. That answering respondents entirely agree with the point that the green belt in land-fill site must be high-density in a small band-width, rather than low-density spread over the land fill site;
9. That answering respondents believe that solid waste management in a city is a task in which it is the citizen's duty to hand over his domestic waste duly segregated; that as such rather than incentivizing the citizen to do this, there should be a system of penalty for those who act irresponsibly and mix up their wet and dry garbage;
10. That availability of non-forest land for use as land-fill site is posing severe challenge in many small towns in Chhattisgarh; that we have therefore represented to Government of India to allow use of forest land for this purpose; that since major requirement of land for composting, this will help not harm the conservation of forests.
11. That use of thermo plastic in place of multi-layer plastic is already common in Chhattisgarh where use of plastic carry bags has been completely banned with effect from 1st January 2015;
