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# STATUS REPORT BY WAY OF AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN LOCAL BODIES DEPARTMENT, HARYANA

- I, D.S Bajwa, Chief Engineer, Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as under:-
- 1. That this Hon'ble Tribunal was pleased to pass the following directions on 11.03.2016, in the above captioned case:

"At request adjourned to 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. In the meanwhile, the Learned Counsel appearing for the State may file affidavit. List the matter on 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 the date already fixed."

2. That it is humbly submitted that the State of Haryana is

following a cluster approach whereby Common Treatment and Disposal Facilities would be constructed for a group of ULBs. 15 common treatment and disposal facilities have been proposed for all ULBs of the State. The clusters have obtained in-principle approval from the Government. Cluster-wise projects would be setup, on integrated



approach and the treatment facilities are envisaged employ most suitable technology for scientific processing of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). This may include waste to energy, composting and refused derived fuel. Such a structure would prevent open dump in the entire state of Haryana. These facilities would be set up on Public Private Partnership basis. Model Request for Proposal (RFP) has been prepared for inviting the proposals from the private agencies. The same was approved by the Committee of Secretaries on Infrastructure (CoSI) in its meeting held on 27.01.2016. The matter was placed before the Cabinet Sub Committee on Infrastructure (CCI) meeting held on 10.03.2016. The same has been approved by the Cabinet Sub Committee on Infrastructure (CCI). The Technical and Financial feasibility study for all clusters is being carried out by the Transaction Advisor. After receiving the minutes of meeting, Request for Proposal (RFP) would be issued and cluster wise projects will be implemented accordingly.

That the location of common treatment and disposal facilities under the cluster approach would be in compliance with the applicable rules/ laws including MSW Rules 2000. The facilities would be setup as per the terms and conditions of the Environmental Clearance. The time frame for further steps to be taken in order to establish the solid waste management plants is given as under:
