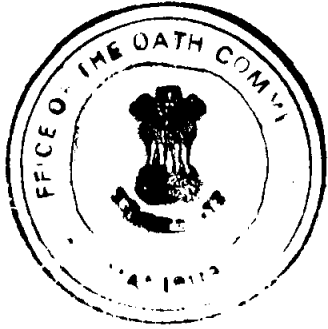

AFFIDAVIT FILED ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF MANIPUR

I, Shri R.K. Dinesh Singh, Secretary (MAHUD), Government of Manipur presently at Imphal do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows:

1. That I am presently serving in the aforesaid capacity and I am authorized to swear this affidavit on behalf of the State of Manipur.
2. That it is humbly submitted that an "Affidavit" was filed in this regard on 21st April, 2015 on behalf of the State of Manipur (copy enclosed).
3. That the deponent further submit that the latest status report with regard to the collection, storage and disposal of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) in the entire state is furnished herewith.
4. That out of 28 (twenty eight) ULBs, door to door collection of MSW is carried out in two cities/towns – Imphal and Kakching. Door to door collection and transportation of MSW from source to the end is outsourced to private agencies in the case of Imphal, while it is done by the ULB in Kakching. In the case of other ULBs, door to door collection has not been initiated. However, the ULBs collect the MSW from crowded bazar areas and transport them to the landfills.
5. That the state of Manipur has adopted as 'Cluster approach' on MSW Management and there are 4 (four) clusters –A, B, C and D. Disposal of MSW for

clusters B, C and D is done in the engineered landfills constructed for the purpose whereas for cluster A, it is done at the MSW plant at Lamdeng. It may be noted that there are no secondary transfer stations at present.

6. That there is a MSW disposal plant at Lamdeng, Imphal and it is a composting plant. As of now, there is no infrastructure for production of RDF or for waste to Energy conversion in this MSW disposal plant. However, the state Government has decided to upgrade the existing MSW – disposal plant so that power can be generated from MSW. RFP has already been floated to rope in reputed private agency for upgradation of the present “composting plant” to “waste to energy plant” and operation thereof.

7. That Manipur Urban Development Agency (MUDA), a registered society under the aegis of Municipal Administration, Housing & Urban Development, Government of Manipur has invited “Financial Bids for preparation of DPR for MSW Management of all the ULBs (28) in Manipur under Swachh Bharat Mission” from all the consultancy firms empaneled by the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India (Annexure A/1).

8. That the deponent further begs to submit additional statement or documents if the need arises for the ends of justice & equity.

Verified that the statements made in para 1 to 7 are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and no material is concealed therein. The Annexure A/1 is the true and correct copy of the original. Para 8 is the humble submission of the deponent before this Hon’ble Tribunal.


The Manipur Urban Development Agency (MUDA), a registered society under the aegis of Municipal Administration, Housing & Urban Development (MAHUD), Government of Manipur hereby invites Financial Bid from your consultancy firm for

- Assistance in preparation of DPR for Municipal Solid Waste Management of all the 28(Twenty eight) Urban Local Bodies of Manipur under Swachh Bharat Mission. The DPR should cover the technology options for door to door collection of waste, segregation at source, transportation, resource recovery, processing and final disposal. The list of ULBs along with population as per 2011 census is enclosed as Annexure-2.
- Assistance to ULBs and MUDA in filling up of the templates for City Sanitation Plan (CSP) of all the ULBs and State Sanitation Strategy (SSS) for claiming release of further installments from the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India.
- Assistance to ULBs in identification of appropriate technology options, design for construction and modalities for operation and maintenance of one public toilet in each city/town covered for DPR preparation.
- To explore the feasibility for managing the municipal solid waste on regional basis by forming clusters to become viable entities to attract private investment.

2. 3. The bidder shall furnish, as part of the financial proposal, an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amounting to Rs 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only. The EMD shall be in the form of Demand Draft from any of the Nationalized Bank or Schedule Bank in favour of the Secretary, MUDA payable at Imphal. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded without any interest after finalization of the successful party by MUDA. EMD of the successful bidder will be retained till the bidder submits the City Sanitation Plan, State Sanitation Strategy and DPR to the concerned agencies. The Earnest Money will be forfeited on account of one or more of the following reasons:

- Bidder withdraws its proposal during the selection process.
- Bidder does not respond to request for clarifications on its proposals submitted to the ULBs or failed to submit an acknowledgement to MUDA within 7 days from the date of receipt of the communication for commencing the work.

4. The DPR has to be prepared as per the guidelines laid down by the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD), Government of India under Swachh Bharat Mission. The DPR will comprise of the entire MSW management process from collection to final disposal of waste consisting of waste segregation and storage at source, primary collection, secondary storage, transportation, secondary segregation, resource recovery, processing, treatment, and final disposal of solid waste. The Manual on Municipal Solid Waste Management, 2000 published by MoUD and revised from time to time may be referenced for DPR preparation.

5. The DPR's for each ULBs/ Cluster of ULBs should be bankable, having a viable financial model emanating from the needs in the City Sanitation Plan and should be aligned with Govt. of India's goals outlined in the NUSP 2008, SWM Rules, Advisories, CPHEEO Manuals (including cost-recovery mechanisms), O&M practices and Service-level Benchmark advisories released by Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India from time to time. Street Sweeping and litter control interventions will be part of the DPR which is essential for a clean city.


6. The State High Powered Committee constituted by the Government of Manipur for implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission in the state will authorize institutes of national repute for appraisal of DPRs prepared by the consultant and submitted to MUDA through the concerned Urban Local Bodies for the technical and economic appraisal prior to according sanction of the project.

7. The technical and economic appraisal by the Institute of national repute will be based on the appraisal format for consideration of projects for solid waste management circulated by the Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organization (CPHEEO) of the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India.

8. The maximum fees payable for DPR preparation will be based on per capita for each ULB/ cluster of ULBs as per the Census population figure of 2011 and the amount quoted along applicable taxes should not exceed the cost admissible for sanction under DPR preparation of Swachh Bharat Mission. There will be no payment for assisting the ULBs and MUDA in filling up of the templates for City Sanitation Plan (CSP) of all the ULBs and State Sanitation Strategy (SSS) for claiming release of further installments from the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India.

9. Further, the consultants are also expected to assist the ULBs in identification of appropriate technology options, design for construction and modalities for operation and maintenance of one public toilet each in every city/town covered by DPR preparation without any extra remuneration.


10. The fees quoted will be considered by a Committee constituted by the Government of Manipur and decision of the State High Power Committee will be final.
11. 50% of the DPR preparation charges will be paid to the consultant on completion of the preparation of DPR, submission to the concerned ULB along with duly filled up templates of City Sanitation Plan with a copy endorsed to MUDA along with State Sanitation Strategy. The balance 50% of the DPR preparation charges will be released only after approval of the DPR by the State High Power Committee on the recommendation of the appraisal agency.
12. Prior to release of the final installment, the consultant should submit a certificate from the ULB concerned stating that the consultant extended all possible assistance to the ULB in identification of appropriate technology options, design for construction and modalities for operation and maintenance of one public toilet in the town.
13. Proposals shall remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days from the date of opening of the financial bid. MUDA reserves the right to reject a proposal valid for a shorter period as non-responsive. MUDA will make best efforts to finalization of the selection process within this period.
14. MUDA will notify the successful bidder in writing after finalization of the selection process. The successful agency has to submit an acknowledgement to MUDA within 7 days from the date of receipt of the communication for commencing the work.
15. Time allowed for preparation of DPR is 60 (sixty) days only from the date of issue of appointment letter by MUDA. If the consultant failed in submission of the DPR within the given time, deduction at the rate of Re 1/- per capita will be made for every 15 days of delay at the time of release of payment to the consultant or adjusted from the Earnest Money.



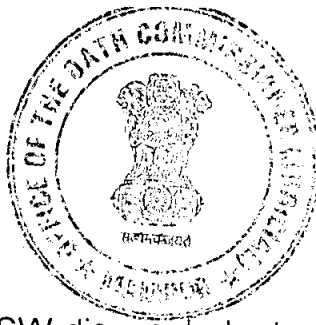

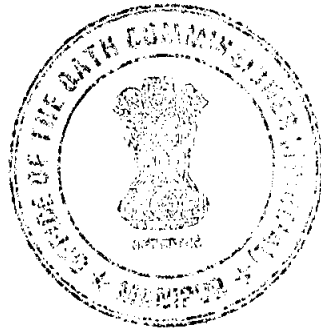
